


Irene Rosten passed away peacefully on December 31, 2024.

Greetings from Inter-County Community Council (ICCC), vour local **Community Action** Agency



This month I wanted to share some information that we learned about through a meeting on mental health, as well as offer some resources that might helpful.

Did you know that 1 in 5 adults will experience mental illness every year. The topic of mental health, often brings a stigma tied to it. This stigma can make it difficult for those struggling to reach out for help. Offering a hand, or an ear to listen with compassion to those struggling can go a long way.

Improving your mental health can come in many different forms. Taking a short break, going for a walk, and ensuring you are getting enough sleep are small things that you can do that may help to improve your mental health. Reaching out to others, and connecting with friends, family and community about your struggles can help build a support network of people that can help you in difficult times.

A mental health crisis can be scary to deal with. Fortunately, there are several supports available:

Spread kindness to others, one small act at a time.

Kindness is a powerful way to connect with others and boost your mood. A simple act of kindness can go a long way.

- Send a "thinking of you" message to a friend or family member
- Smile at people as you pass by
- Ask someone about their day
- Give a stranger a compliment
- Be kind to you. Treat yourself to something you enjoy

Take a 5-minute vacation.

Press "pause" and just be in

When life gets busy, or your thoughts are racing, stop. Press "pause" and take 5 minutes to slow down and just be in the moment.

This 5-4-3-2-1 'in the moment' technique can help to refocus your mind and calm your body:

Name 5 things you can see

Notice 4 things you can touch

Name 3 things you can hear

Identify 2 things you can smell

Notice 1 thing you can taste






First Communion

Parish Board meeting January 9, 2025 7:00 p.m.

Roll Call: David Hofstad, Josh Vettleson, Cheryl O'Neill and Gin Berns. Secretary/Treasurer Bonny Cote

Cheryl called the meeting to order. The minutes from the last meeting were read. A motion by David, seconded by Josh, all in favor, carried.

Financial report was given by Bonny and approved with a motion by Josh, seconded by Gin.

Bonny presented the Annual meeting report. The board looked through the report, changes were noted. Bonny will make the changes and then print the report for the annual meetings. Gin made the motion to approve, David seconded it. Carried.

New Business:

Bonny had received a email from Shannon Moen in December stating that Shannon, Robin Morinville and Amanda Nelson were resigning from the Youth Group. So Bonny after the first of the year, when to the bank with the email and had them removed from the Youth Group accounts and the Debit Card discontinued.

The Board had received an email from Father Bryan Kajawa from St. Francis. He wanted to talk to our board and try to get more community minded. Cheryl met with Father and they had a nice talk about how to grow our community and fellowship of our churches.
