Faith Lutheran Church Supports Lutheran World Relief



Faith Lutheran Church in Bagley recently delivered 23 boxes containing 193 Personal Care Kits and 18 quilts to the Lutheran World Relief (LWR) ingathering site in Thief River Falls. The items will be sent to LWR's warehouse in Baltimore, Maryland, for distribution to people in need.

LWR began providing aid to war-torn Europe after World War II and continues to support communities around the world and, more recently, disaster victims within the United States.

Faith Lutheran youth Kaden and Brennen Melander helped load the shipment, while longtime volunteers Jerry and Sue Davidson, accompanied by their pup Cindi Blu, delivered the kits and quilts to Thief River Falls. Their dedication helps bring comfort and care to those facing hardship.



"I am worthy" Bible study in Gather

This summer, Women of the ELCA participants will gather in Des Moines, Iowa, under the theme "I am worthy." When Nobel Peace Prize winner Leymah Gbowee spoke in 2017, she invited WELCA participants to reclaim space for women and girls to lead and love in bold ways. KATIE'S FUND 2122—Grant Applications are Open!



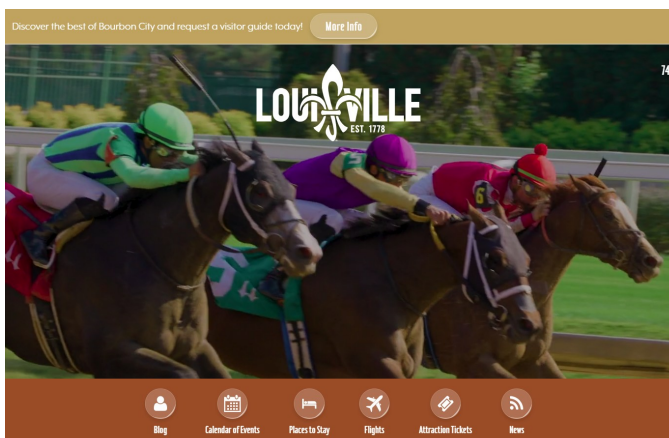
Katie's Fund Grants are allocated to support programs, resources, and opportunities in the areas named when the Fund was first begun.

These grants in the amount of \$500-\$5,000 are designed to support project resources, and opportunities in the areas of leadership development, global sharing and living theology.

You will need to register before you can submit your application.

Katie's Fund Grants processes will have two annual cycles. The first cycle opens on June 30 each year, with all completed applications due by September 1. Determinations will be made by October 1, with the distribution of funds completed by November 1. A final report from the grantee is due by November 1. The second cycle will open on November 1 each year, with all completed applications due by February 1. Determinations will be made by March 1, with the distribution of funds completed by April 1.
