



This month I wanted to share a bit about food resources for income eligible households.

SNAP stands for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. In the past this program has been called food support or food stamps. You can apply online for this program or check to see if you are eligible at: https://mnbenefits.mn.gov/

This year there is a nationwide Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer program that provides families with school-aged children eligible for free or reduced-price school meals a one-time payment of \$120.00 per child. Households will receive a new card for these funds and it will be in the child's name. The envelopes that these cards come in are generic and could be mistaken for junk mail so please check your mail closely. The funds will be available in late July or August. If you are already enrolled in the SNAP benefit your child should automatically be enrolled.

Another resource that the University of Minnesota Extension and North Dakota State University Extension created is the 2024 Summer Meal Guide for busy parents on a budget. This free tool is packed with ideas for meals and snacks and contains weekly shopping lists. It can be found at: https://reallifegoodfood.umn.edu/resources/summer-meals-snap

If you need help applying for these resources our staff can assist you with the application process. Or if you need access to a computer and a printer just give us a call, we would be happy to help.

Cell phones are wonderful for scanning photos. One of my favorites for the iPhone is Genius Scan as it will eliminate distortion cause by the angle you hold the phone. Be sure to send photos as jpgs, not pdfs. Also send them at the highest resolution possible and the largest size possible. This is necessary so it will reproduce well in the book. If you'd rather, you can give the photos to Alice to scan and give back to you.

We are looking at a deadline of Dec 31, 2024, for including family histories. That's eleven months away, but don't wait until your backs are against the wall! You might want to do a little research of your own about your family!

Special Parish Council Meeting

Parish Special Board Meeting

June 6, 2024

Meeting was called to order by Cheryl O'Neill.

The items to be discussed were:

- 1. Parsonage Rental
- 2. Block Party
- 3. Survey
- 4. Heat Pump replacement
- 5. Cleaning of Parsonage

Cleaning of the house was discussed first. The board was wondering about hiring someone and Gin said she charges \$20 an hour. It was decided to have a Parsonage Workday and announcing to people that June 19th will be the day to come help inside or outside. Inside things need to be washed (cabinets, counters, floors, etc.) and outside, trees need to be trimmed and bushes cut back. Clean up the flower beds, etc. People who are coming to help should bring supplies for whatever they are choosing to do that day. Starting at 3 p.m. until done or dark.

Parsonage: The Parish has been approached about renting out the parsonage for a short term by Oak Park. Their current pastor is not able to work for a long period of time and the ones filling in are looking for a short-term rental. It was decided to offer the parsonage to them for \$1200 a month (includes heat, water, sewer, and garbage). A motion was made by David H, seconded by Kyle V. Carried.

The annual Block Party was discussed. The date is set for Wednesday, July 10th. It will be a

community event – Potluck – everyone should bring a dish to share. The Parish will supply hotdogs & buns, St. Francis Xavier will supply paper goods and beverages. Bonny will reserve the hall in case of inclement weather. It will start at 5 p.m. and finish at 7 p.m. Bonny will put ad in paper and make posters.

Heat Pump: The cost of a heat pump two years ago was just over \$5,000. Bonny said that since we are not paying for a pastor at this time, this might be a good time to get it replaced as the parish funds are increasing due to no pastor and pulpit supply is about a \$1200 a month. The board asked for quotes to be gotten from Smeby in McIntosh, Wilcox, and Lovely. Will discuss at the next meeting.

Survey: All the envelopes were opened and tallied. Final numbers are listed on the front page of the newsletter for July. The board was happy that around 50 people responded. Bonny & Cheryl reported that pulpit supply is in short supply, but so far we were covered until July 21st. Bonny will talk to the two that are scheduled to do services in the coming weeks and ask it they can supply us with more dates.

Board asked question if we don't have a permanent person in place by fall, what about confirmation. Bonny suggested that if that happens, we should be talking to maybe the Plummer Parish about sending our kids over there. This has been done before, churches sharing services like confirmation.

Last question was about rental agreements? Do we do a background check if we want to continue to rent out the parsonage after the Oak Park group no longer needs it? Some places charge a fee to apply.

A motion was made to close the meeting by David Hofstad/seconded by everyone!

Lord's Prayer was said.

Next meeting will be July 2nd at 7:00 p.m. at Zion.

Salem Lutheran Church Council Meeting Notes – June 11th, 2024

Attendance: David, Lisa, Shirley, Paula, Ginny, Wyatt, Toni, Josh, Erica, Ron.

Secretary's report read by: Paula. Approved by 1st Josh, 2nd by Ron. **Treasurer's report** read by: Lisa. Approved by 1st Paula, 2nd by Ginny

Old Business: Insurance Agency came out to the church with Wyatt to view building for the new insurance policy. It was approved and new policy is in place. An ad was placed in the newspaper for the cemetery fund for headstones that need repair. Valley cemetery maintenance was called for headstone repair estimate. Quarter round for the flooring is needed, Lisa will reach out to Leif to find out if that was ordered. Bathrooms need to be remodeled; Lisa will revisit the previous list of items needed for cost; we will reassess after the plumbing is fixed, see new business. Door Handle needs to be replaced; property management take on replacing the door locks. West door may need to be fully replaced; Josh will consider the cost of a new door.

New Business: Valley Cemetery Maintenance quoted \$350 for small/ground stone cement repair and \$500 for large cement repair <u>per headstone</u>. Discussion to fix multiple headstones per year as funds allow. We will run an ad in the newspaper, share on Facebook, and add to the newsletter. Money will be used from the Cemetery perpetual care funds, and we will continue to raise money. Motion to spend \$2,000 per year as continued maintenance for cemetery headstones: 1st Shirley, 2nd Toni. Motion approved.

Plumbing seems to be blocked in both bathrooms; Tyrone Olson will come to check on the pipes this week. Bathroom remodel quote cost is \$1,300. TR Glass will donate the flooring install, 2-bathroom signs are needed. Paula will order signs, and Lisa is purchasing the remaining items for the remodel. Bonny has been taking care of our pulpit supply.

2 Reserved parking signs will be place on the east side of the building for Pastor parking and closer parking for anyone in need of a shorter walking distance.

VBS is August $5^{th} - 8^{th}$ 6 – 8:30pm. Erica will meet with ladies' aid to discuss meals during VBS.

Upcoming 130th Celebration – July 13th, 2025. Planning will be a continued discussion. From last meeting: Shirley will prepare the church directory. Alice is preparing history book. There will be a morning meal for the celebration, Toni and Sandra will oversee the meal. Possible other options for the celebration, chime choir or Sunday school kids singing.

Salem continues to need help cleaning the church, anyone available please sign up in the entry way poster board.

Closed with the Lord's Prayer.
